

New 3.0ML tank takes form at Numurkah

CONSTRUCTION of Goulburn Valley Water's new 3.0 megalitre tank at the Numurkah Water Treatment Plant in Knox Street is beginning to take form.

Goulburn Valley Water General Manager Technical Services, Bruce Hammond said residents may have noticed some action at the site.

"This project involves construction of a concrete tank to assure security of supply to

the Numurkah township," said Mr Hammond. "We also remind customers of the exciting plans for a vegetation and landscaping development project which will greatly improve the aesthetics of the site."

The tank will be partially buried, with a waterwise garden to surround the base. "Completion of the project is anticipated by October 2010 with the landscaping project to follow," Mr Hammond said.
